

Gisborne COCKROACH

Drymapaneta semivitta

This cockroach was discovered in Gisborne and then the Bay of Plenty and Auckland in the 1960s. It is now established around New Zealand. It is wingless and can grow to 25mm in length. It will come into houses but prefers to live among wood piles and other debris in gardens, parks and wasteland. It is an Australian insect.
