Crocodiles don't eat an awful lot. A large croc can easily survive on one good meal a month. Crocs have a slow metabolism that burns little fuel and so are ideally suited to unstable environments that have irregular, inconsistent food supplies - food sources that would defeat other animals with high food demands.

Juveniles feed on small prey such as insects, crustaceans, small turtles, fish and rodents.

Mature animals feed on smaller crocs, kangaroos, waterfowl, feral pigs, turtles, wallabies, dingoes etc - and occasionally humans.
