Show your commitment towards NZ Conservation by making your own classroom Kiwi

Objective:

Identify ways to contribute towards the survival of living things in NZ

Resources:

Copies of the attached feather outline for each child in your class. Alternatively, you can make your own using coloured paper

Large copy of the Kiwi outline to stick the completed feathers onto



Activity:

- Discuss the idea of conservation with students. Talk about this as an example: the care and protection of resources including habitats of living things.
- Discuss what do we do daily that has impact on the habitat of living things including ourselves as humans. Some examples include: litter going into the ocean or being eaten as food, being wasteful with food or water in bathrooms when brushing teeth, turning lights off.
- Discuss how we could improve these things to result in having lesser impact on resources.
- Discuss some statements of commitment that student could write on the feathers.
- Get students to colour in the feathers to represent themselves and the commitment they made to NZ Conservation
