TRACKING TUNNEL

Objective:

Identify what type of predators are in your surroundings

Resources:

- Ink pad - this can be homemade by using a container lid with tissue paper or a sponge and food colouring
- Peanut butter on a container lid (use honey or other food if allergy prone)
- Milk bottle or cardboard to make tunnel with
- Paper to line the tunnel
- Piece of wood



Activity:

1. Discuss the purpose a predator tracking tunnel. Look at pictures of different predator footprints
2. Watch making a tracking tunnel [video](#)
3. Get students to make predictions of what predators they think they might find in different settings
4. Get students to write steps down following watching the video of how to make the tunnel and any modifications they might make.
5. Get making your tunnel!
6. Keep a diary of tracking activity - look on the internet to identify the predator that is roaming your area.
