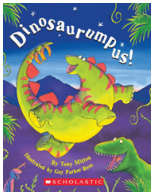


DISCOVERING DINOSAURS

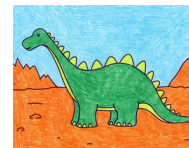

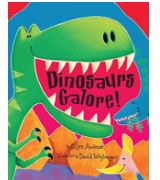
