


A fossil is the <u>preserved remains</u> of a <u>plant</u> or <u>animal</u>. They are <u>rocks</u>. <u>Fossils</u> are <u>rare</u> because an <u>organism</u> needs to be quickly covered by <u>sediment</u> in order to be turned into a fossil. The fossilisation process takes thousands of years. Most fossils are uncovered when rocks are worn away by <u>wind</u> and <u>water</u>.
