Butterfly Creek is the perfect place to visit for a safe, fun and educational day trip. Our living classroom offers your tamariki a chance to learn about the animal world and connect with nature. It's easy to walk around, even for little legs, and a great day out rain or shine as 75% of our exhibits are undercover.

ATTRACTIONS

Popular attractions include our Butterfly House, Dinosaur Kingdom, Kiwi Forest, Mythical Creatures, Buttermilk Farm and New Zealand's only saltwater crocodiles. We also have a fun. short train ride.

ANIMAL ENCOUNTERS

We have 9 free daily animal encounters including our popular crocodile feeding encounter at 1pm. Children also have the opportunity to have a hands-on experience in Buttermilk Farm where they can feed and pet rabbits, guinea pigs, goats and other animals.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

A group coordinator will meet you on arrival and get you set up for the day. They will run over some basic health and safety rules and highlight the free animal encounter times that you are welcome to attend. You will then be able to guide yourselves around the complex.
